While you may be familiar with Fritz Lang's 1927 film, you may not know that

METROPOLIS was originally a novel written by his wife, Thea Von Harbou, two years

earlier. The basis for Fritz Lang's iconic 1927 film, Von Harbou's novel illuminates

essential parts of the story lost on the cutting-room floor.

In the future, wealthy industrialists and business magnates and their top employees

reign over the city of Metropolis from colossal skyscrapers, while underground-

dwelling workers toil to operate the great machines that power it.

Freder, the upperclass son of the all-powerful master of Metropolis, falls for a worker

from below named Maria and searches the depths of the city for her. Along the way

he opposes his father, discovers the oppressed conditions of the labourers, trades

places with a worker, and encounters a mad scientist Rotwang who has created an

evil robot in the image of Maria.

Metropolis revolves around the social crisis between workers and employers in a

capitalist system, with a love story at its centre. After all.. The mediator between brain

and muscle must be the heart!

If those in the Sydney cast are unable to participate in any following seasons we will be recasting from this current set of auditions.

This is an all-new musical currently in development, with musical influences including Dave Malloy, Samuel Barber, Jeanine Tesori, Kurt Weill, Kate Miller-Meidke and Adam Guettel.

Auditionees are required to prepare one piece of music, no more than 2 minutes in length. Please pick a song that you feel reflects your voice in its most comfortable range and style - part of the process of creating this show will be tailoring the work to each cast member's strengths, so we would love to see you sing something that shows us who you are as a performer.

While your song choice does not need to be strictly Musical Theatre, it should still be somewhat theatrical in style and delivery.

Please bring clearly marked sheet music, in the correct key, as there will be an accompanist present for all auditions.

Auditionees may also be asked to do a cold read on the day.

Auditions will be held in person. If absolutely necessary, artists may request a video submission, although in person is preferred. Callback auditions will be held in the final week of January.

You are welcome to submit for a particular role, however if you are called in for an audition, it may be for another role or multiple roles - please refer to the character descriptions and requirements.

# **CASTING DESCRIPTIONS:**

Little Eggs prides itself on strong ensemble performance. While there are particular key roles being cast, it is likely most performers will play multiple roles in the production.

# Freder - Leading Role:

20s / early 30s

Freder is the son of Joh Frederson, who is the ruler of Metropolis. He is bright-eyed and earnest and at times naive, but these qualities lead him to work towards enacting real political change and helping his society.

Freder is also framed as a musician. If you are proficient in an instrument please let us know.

# Maria / Robot Maria - Leading Role:

20s / early 30s

Maria is gentle, ethical, politically idealistic, and pure of heart. She is seen by the workers as a kind of prophet and holds sermons in the underground city about the importance of uniting the ruling class with the working class.

The actor who plays Maria will also play Robot Maria, the monster brought to life by Rotwang the scientist in the image of Maria. Robot Maria is a sinful and chaotic entity, tasked with leading the charge towards mass destruction in the city.

### Joh Frederson:

40s-60s

Frederson is a very calculating person and seems cold in personality, indifferent to the squalid conditions that so concern his more idealistic son. He is the head of Metropolis and the leader of the ruling classes.

# **Rotwang:**

30s - 60s

Rotwang is a reclusive scientist who was once friends with Joh and competed with him for a woman in their youth. He is an immoral chaos-loving eccentric who has no regrets about the suffering of others.

#### **Grot:**

30s - 50s

The foreman of the workers and the guardian of the Heart Machine. He is stoic, and physically intimidating. He tries to defend the Heart Machine from the workers during the revolution, but fails. Later, he leads them in their search for the False Maria.

# **Ensemble:**

We are looking for an ensemble of five multidisciplinary artists. The Ensemble will cover a number of different roles, have strong sense of musicality and ability to hold close harmonies. Ideally, the ensemble are also confident movers.

#### **VACCINATION STATUS**
